

ICELANDIC Circle Tour

August 3 - 12, 2017

Our fully escorted circle island tour shows you the ever-changing scenery of the Icelandic countryside: mountains and valleys, volcanoes, glaciers, rivers, hot springs and waterfalls. This is an ideal tour for those who want to experience all of the variety of the Icelandic landscape, culture and history.

Thu. Aug. 3: U.S. Departure

Departure from the U.S. today. Overnight flight to Iceland.

Fri. Aug. 4: Arrival Iceland

Transfer will be arranged from the airport to our hotel. The drive takes about 45 minutes and takes you through the lunar landscape and moss covered lava fields of the Reykjanes Peninsula.

Overnight stay in Reykjavik

Sat. Aug. 5: Geysir – Gullfoss – Skogar – Dyrholaey – Vik

Exploding Geysers – Waterfalls – Puffin Colony – Black Sand Beaches of the South Shore

Start the day with a short city sightseeing tour of **Reykjavik**. From Reykjavik head through the village of **Hveragerdi** to explore **Gullfoss**, the "Golden Waterfall", and the nearby Geysir **hot spring** area to see the famous **Geysir** and Strokkur, and numerous other hot springs and **boiling mud pools**. Continue along the south shore and stop to admire the **waterfalls** Seljalandsfoss and **Skogafoss** before continuing to Dyrholaey* **nature reserve**.

Dinner and overnight stay in the Vik area.

Sun. Aug. 6: Vik – Skaftafell National Park – Jokulsarlon Glacial Lagoon – Hofn

Lava Fields – Europe's Largest National Park – Glacial Lagoon with Icebergs – Europe's Largest Glacier

Cross Eldhraun, the largest mass of **lava** ever to flow in recorded history, before reaching the small town

Kirkjubaejarklaustur, site of a 12th-century Catholic convent. The tour continues over Skeidararsandur sands to Skaftafell National Park. Continue to the stunning Jokulsarlon Glacial Lagoon to see the birthplace of icebergs. Throughout the day we are afforded magnificent views of the mighty Vatnajokull Glacier.

Dinner and overnight stay in the Hofn area.

Mon. Aug. 7: Hofn - East Fjords - Egilsstadir

Narrow Fjords – Steep Mountains – Picturesque Coastline – Mineral Collection

Drive from Hofn through Almannaskard pass; stop and admire the majestic coastline. Continue to the towering mountains, plunging vertically into the sea, that form the magnificent East Fjords. Explore Petra's renowned collection of local stones and minerals.

Dinner and overnight stay in the Egilsstadir area.

Tue. Aug. 8: Lake Myvatn Area

Dinner and overnight stay in the Myvatn area.

Highland Desert – Bizarre Lava Formations – Geothermal & Volcanic Activity – Rich Birdlife – Protected Salmon River
Explore the empty vastness of the highland desert plateau
Modrudalsoraefi, heading to the Lake Myvatn area. On the way, we'll make a stop at Dettifoss, Europe's most powerful waterfall. Onwards to Namaskard pass with its boiling mud pools and vibrant colours. Explore the natural beauty of the Lake Myvatn area, the pseudo craters at Skutustadir and Laxa salmon river. One of the Myvatn area's claims to fame is that it is home to more species of ducks than any other place on Earth, with very diverse birdlife in general.

Wed. Aug. 9: Lake Myvatn Area - Akureyri

Waterfall Of the Gods – Folk Museum – Iceland's Second Largest City

Start the day exploring the **peculiar lava formations** at Dimmuborgir. Continue to the bustling northern port of **Akureyri**, making a stop at the **magnificent Godafoss waterfall** and the **old turffarm** Laufas. Akureyri has some of the finest timber buildings in the country, beautifully restored to their original glory.

Overnight stay in the Akureyri area.

Thu. Aug. 10: Skagafjordur – Borgarnes

Fertile Farmlands – Glacial Rivers – Unique Viking Horse with Demonstration

Majestic mountains and narrow passes lead to **Skagafjordur** for an introduction to the **Icelandic horse**, which has a unique fifth gait, the tolt. Continue to the village of Blonduos, which is built on both sides of the river Blanda, with Hrutey Island a protected nature reserve, located nearby in the middle of a popular salmon river. Cross the Holtavorduheidi plateau through Borgarfjordur to the beautiful town of Borgarnes. Dinner and overnight stay in Borgarnes area.

Fri. Aug. 11: Borgarfjordur – Thingvellir – Reykjavik

Europe's Largest Hot Spring – Picturesque Waterfalls – National Park with Geological Wonders (UNESCO)

Drive to **Deildartunguhver**, the most powerful hot spring in the world. Stop to admire the beautiful **Hraunfossar waterfalls**, before continuing via Hvalfjordur fjord to **Lake**

Thingvallavatn, Iceland's largest lake, and Thingvellir National Park, the ancient site of the world's first outdoor parliament. Overnight stay in Reykjavik.

Sat. Aug. 12: Departure

Our transfer will depart the hotel approx. 3,5 hours before your flight departure and deliver you to Keflavík International Airport.

DEPOSIT: A deposit of \$500 per person is required to confirm your reservation. This is a private group tour and space is limited. Make your deposit as soon as possible to secure your reservation.

FINAL PAYMENT: Final payment is due no later than June 1, 2017.
